

COTMAN UPDATE: DELIVERY

COTMAN version 6.0 will be available for distribution to Arkansas producers and crop advisors through their local county Extension office for 2000. This program is a DOS-based program very similar to the program used in 1999. A windows-based version of COTMAN is under development and should be ready for release in 2001.

The COTMAN program can be executed on IBM® compatible computers equipped with DOS 3.0®, Windows 95®, or higher operating systems. The computer should have 512K of free RAM and a hard drive with at least 1.5MB free disk space. Compatible color graphics capabilities include CGA, EGA, and VGA.

COTMAN may be ordered by obtaining a COTMAN request form from your local county Extension agent. Cost of the program is \$15 for new users and \$5 for updates for previous users. Your old COTMAN diskette should be returned with your request form and check to obtain an update. The manual printed in 1998 for COTMAN v5.0 is still applicable for v6.0 and will be sent to new users. A new manual will be sent to those receiving updates only upon request. The program will be mailed to users from the State Extension Headquarters in Little Rock.

Training and support for COTMAN will originate at the county level and will be offered to users at no charge. Contact your local county Extension agent to request a copy of COTMAN or to receive more information concerning COTMAN.
